






















Previous Review

China (Chengdu) New Energy Int' I Forum & Solar Energy Fair 2009, co-sponsored by United Nations Development Program, Chinese Renewable Energy Society and Chengdu Municipal People's Government, has closed in success. Focusing on the theme "The Opportunities & Challenges of New Energy Industry", the forum was rolled out in one main forum and four parallel forums and attracted, from nine countries, 180-odd experts, 700-odd attendees, 300-odd new energy enterprises, 118 business executives and 80-downward corporate exhibitors and 26 thousand visitors, making the most widely recognized new energy event in western China in terms of scale, rank, professionalism and influence.
